New Developments for Pharma-Related IP Matters in Europe

Brief Description: European IP may look somewhat complex and requires frequent updating for those who deal with it from the US. The Cabinet Regimbeau team handles a number of high profile companies and cases and has chosen to keep you posted on two especially hot issues for pharma-related IP matters in Europe: clinical trials and pan-European litigation.

The presentation will comprise three main parts:

- Protecting “clinical trials” type of inventions in Europe: what can be protected? Recent case law of the European Patent Office (Franck Tetaz)
- Protecting your interest with clinical trials conducted in Europe – what you need to do before, during and after clinical trials in order to secure ownership of all the IP generated during those trials that you sponsor; types of agreements with European organizations conducting such trials (Jacques Warcoin)
- “Evergreening” strategies and how to defend a Pharma company facing generics market entry in Europe – Pan European litigation (Frédérique Faivre Petit)

Frédérique Faivre Petit

Frédérique Faivre Petit is currently a partner in the Biotechnology Group of Cabinet Regimbeau in Paris. After a first experience as French Patent Attorney in a large IP law firm in Paris, Frédérique Faivre Petit joined Cabinet Regimbeau where she initially worked for ten years. During that time she became a European Patent Attorney and obtained her Law degree (“Legal Procedure and Criminal Sciences”) from Université de Paris II. She developed an experience in patent litigation related to biological and pharmaceutical products. She also did attend regularly oral proceedings at the European Patent Office representing French and foreign clients as patentee or opponent.

For the past two years, before recently re-joining Cabinet Regimbeau, she was responsible for Patent Litigation in Europe at Sanofi-Aventis, organising the defensive and offensive patent litigation strategy for the group in Europe.

Frank Tetaz, Cabinet Regimbeau, Partner, Head of the Lyon Office

Trained by Francis Ahner and Jacques Warcoin in Paris, Franck Tetaz was in charge of the Industrial Property department for Aventis CropScience in Lyon with a focus on biotechnologies and genomics. He gained particular experience in IP litigations in the United States in lawsuits before juries and courts of arbitration. Today he is Partner and Head of the Lyon agency of Regimbeau, further developing the firm’s installation of the great South-East and Alpine Arc. His areas of expertise include biotechnology, molecular biology, genetic engineering, biology, micro-organisms, plants, animal genomics, proteomic therapeutic targets, drug design and combinative chemistry, medicine, pharmacy diagnostic organic chemistry, cosmetics, agro-alimentary and phytochemistry.
