Topic: “A Year After *Quanta*”

“Developments in the Law of Patent Exhaustion Since the Supreme Court’s Decision”

Brief Description

The Supreme Court issued its long-awaited decision on patent exhaustion on June 9, 2008. In the year since then, both the lower courts and parties to patent license agreements have had to address the potentially far-reaching implications of the decision and its underlying rationale. This seminar will focus on what's happened both in the courts and in practice, including recent cases on patent non-assertion covenants and the effects of first sales that occur outside the United States (the so-called "international exhaustion" issue).

From 101 North or South:

- From 101 North or South: Exit at Oregon Expressway. Proceed west on Oregon to El Camino.
- Cross El Camino (Oregon becomes Page Mill Rd.). Turn left on Ramos (first light after El Camino).
- You have entered Palo Alto Square.
- Go to the second stop sign and turn right. Park anywhere and take the red brick walkway between the two buildings.
